ORDINANCE FOR FIRE PROTECTION

On a motion by Ralph Beckly, seconded by Werner Semling
the Town Board of the Town of Milton adopts the following ordinance:

The Town of Milton as a participating member of the Fountain City Area Fire Association and with the recommendation of the Fire Association Board does hereby adopt the following ordinance with regard to services provided by said Fire Association to non-contracted entities with interests or functions in the Town of Milton.

Such non-contracted entities shall include: public utilities, railroad companies, federal, state and county land, highways and other properties, and any and all other non-contracted entity with functions or interests in the Town of Milton.

Since such non-contracted entities do not participate financially in the operations of said Fire Association and since it is the responsibility of said Fire Association to provide service and protection to such entities a rate for such services is required.

With the recommendation of the Fire Association Board the Town of Milton shall hereafter bill non-contracted entities ~~\$150.00~~ per call, per fire fighting unit (unit shall consist of one pumper truck and one tank or water truck as is required by law).

Labor per personnel shall presently be at the rate of ~~\$4.00~~ per hour per man responding to the call, and shall hereafter be adjusted and billed at the current rate as established by the association.

Whereas, it is in the best interest of the Fire Association and the Town of Milton the Cochrane-Fountain City School District shall be the only exception to the above resolution and shall be charged for services as a contracted member of the association.

The Town Board reserves the right to accept payment of a lesser amount than provided for by the ordinance in such cases as a non-contracted entity being restricted by state or federal law.
