ROADWAY ORDINANCE

The Town Board of Milton Township hereby adopts and places in effect the following Ordinance with respect to assuming responsibility of new, and/or, existing roadways:

1. The Township shall not be responsible, nor share in the cost in the principle construction of new roadways for individual properties nor new roadways to service multi-family developments; nor commercial developments.

Such construction and/or development may later be accepted by the Township when requirements as later defined by this Ordinance are met and such roadway has been determined to be beneficial and in the best interest to the Township.

2. The Township shall not assume responsibility of existing roadways which currently are not Town Roads unless such roadways meet all requirements of State, County and Township Statutes and assuming responsibility is beneficial and in the best interest to the Township. Requirements necessary to meet aforementioned shall be defined later in said Ordinance.

3. All parties interested in construction or development of new roadways and/or requests for the Township to assume responsibility of existing roadways shall contact the Town Board in writing of such intent. The Board shall then examine and act on such request.

4. Prior to the Township accepting responsibility any and all of the following must be met by the individuals making the request. The entire cost of which shall be the responsibility of the individual or individuals making the request:

- A. The Roadway bed must be of suitable width to meet all State, County and Township Statutes necessary to receive Highway Aid at the time of request.
- B. The Roadway bed must be ^{blacktopped.} ~~of crushed rock or otherwise improved to the extent that future improvements, such as blacktop mat can be placed without extensive improvements.~~
- C. All requirements such as Deeds, legal descriptions, surveyors work and any or all other legal matters as may be necessary for the Township to assume responsibility shall have been completed by the interested individuals at no cost to the Township.
